## CHALLENGE ONE

### Manual processes created duplicate work

The department spent 20–30 hours a week managing spreadsheet schedules. Frequent updates had to be made manually, often requiring duplication of work. Any changes meant printing new versions and re-distributing them physically.


### ✓ OUTCOME

### Automated schedules saving them time

PowerTime allowed real-time schedule updates that eliminated duplication and printing. Chief Zerbe can now build schedules for the whole year and adjust them quickly, reducing time spent on scheduling by over 25% — saving 10+ hours per week.

## CHALLENGE TWO

### Limited visibility of the schedule

Officers had to call in or check a printed schedule in the squad room to confirm shifts, court dates, or time off. Shift trades and requests weren't transparent, making planning difficult and leading to communication gaps.

### ✓ OUTCOME

### Anywhere access keeping everyone in sync

Officers can now view schedules, make requests, and check availability from any device. The web-based platform centralizes communication and automates notifications — improving visibility, reducing confusion, and enhancing responsiveness.
